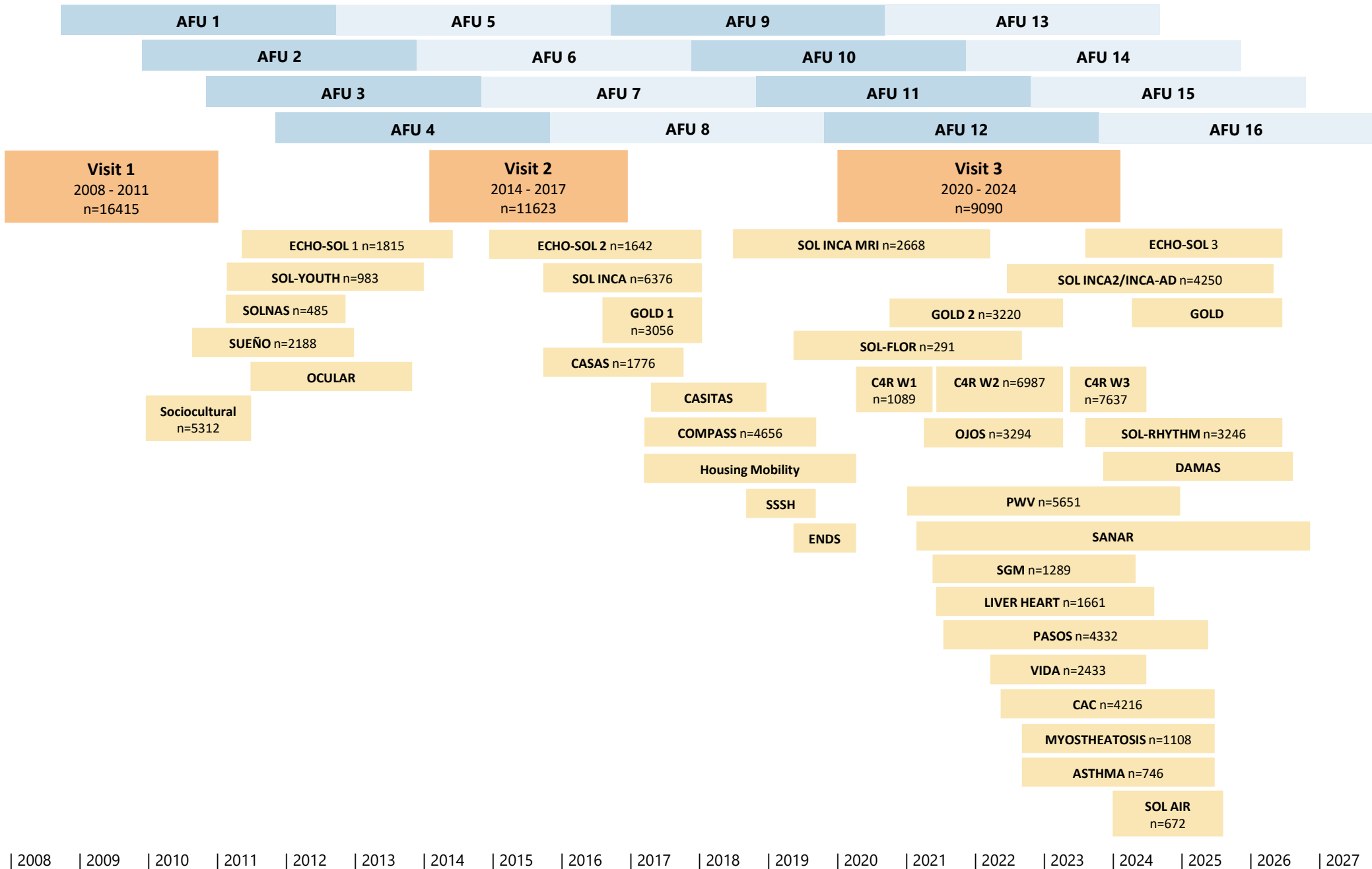




Timeline 2008 – 2027, with 16,415 Original Enrolled Participants, Annual Follow-Up (AFU) and Visits
